



CODE OF CONDUCT (SCHEDULE ONE)

Students are expected to abide by the school values and expectations when in school uniform or when engaged in activities that are associated with the school. At these times a student is deemed to be under the jurisdiction of the school.

School Uniform is to be worn tidily and correctly, both at school and between home and school at all times, including the journey to and from school. Hair must be clean and tidy and excesses of current fashions are not acceptable. Boys are to be clean-shaven. Students may also wear one small, plain gold or silver stud earring in the lobe of the ear or small plain sleepers. Māori pounamu taonga is welcome. Non-regulation items, including jewellery, maybe confiscated. Tattoos, cultural or otherwise, must not be visible, unless permission is provided by the school.

The following items are not to be brought on to the school grounds:

- Alcohol
- Drugs
- Any device/paraphernalia associated with drugs
- Synthetic cannabis
- Chemicals
- Cigarettes or tobacco
- Vaping devices/vaping liquids
- Glass bottles
- Knives or any other weapons
- Imitation weapons
- Lasers
- Chewing gum
- Lighters/Matches
- Explosive or dangerous materials
- Marker pens
- Skateboards/Scooters
- Other costly equipment

Computer devices are a part of classroom activities. The use of these is at the discretion of all teachers and must be appropriate to purpose. It is expected that devices are brought to school fully charged and ready for use. Students must follow the OHS ICT Code of Conduct Agreement when using devices at school.

Earphones are not permitted to be worn, seen on, or used by students during school hours.

Mobile phones cannot be used on school grounds. Students must put their phones away for the day before they enter the school. Phones may be confiscated if used.

The following is not permitted:

- the unauthorised taking of any still or moving images
- the unauthorised sharing or posting (electronic or otherwise) of any audio recordings and/or still or moving images

Students are not permitted to travel in a vehicle that is being driven by the holder of a restricted or learner licence.

Bicycles are to be stored in the bike racks. They should be securely locked to the racks. Basic Traffic Department Road Safety Rules must be obeyed on the way to and from school. Bicycles may not be ridden in school grounds. It is compulsory for all students riding bicycles to wear a helmet.

The use of any food delivery services, e.g. Uber Eats, to the school grounds to students, is prohibited because this poses potential safety risks.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT **(SCHEDULE ONE)**

The student agrees to the following whilst enrolled at Onehunga High School (OHS):

1. To follow the curfew times set by OHS, which are as follows: Students of all ages should be home between the hours of 6:00PM to 6:30AM from Sunday to Thursday evenings. Students of all ages should be home between the hours of 9:30PM to 6:30AM on Friday and Saturday evenings.
2. To keep their host parents informed of where they are going and who they are with (when not attending school).
3. To not spend the night anywhere but at their OHS assigned residential caregiver's house.
4. To not travel outside of Auckland City without the written permission of OHS and their parents. This includes overseas travel e.g. returning home.
5. To abide by all house rules that their residential caregiver sets for them e.g. keeping their bedroom tidy, asking permission for friends to come over, respecting the family's property and belongings, completing basic household chores.
6. To arrive at OHS on time, with all required learning materials and study to the best of their ability.
7. To immediately notify their residential caregiver if they are unable to attend school for any reason.
8. To not own or drive any form of motorized vehicle e.g. car, motorcycle, electric scooter.
9. To not possess, purchase or smoke cigarettes or any vaping products/equipment.
10. To not possess, purchase, sell, distribute or consume alcohol regardless of age.
11. To not possess, purchase, sell, distribute or consume illegal drugs or any mind-altering substances.
12. To not possess or purchase any dangerous materials or items, e.g. knives, weapons, guns, chemicals.
13. To not physically harm, mentally harm or discriminate against any other person/s e.g. hit, punch, bully, tease.

14. To always have a NZ mobile number for their phone and provide OHS International Department with this phone number.
15. To not use any digital devices past 10:00PM on a school night (in order to get a proper night's rest and not come to school tired or late).
16. To not visit any illegal, objectionable, offensive, dangerous or inappropriate websites.
17. To not work (either with or without pay) without notifying the Director of International Students and obtaining the correct work visa entitlements.

The student understands that if they do not keep to their agreement and follow the code of conduct whilst enrolled at Onehunga High School, that the investigation policy may be followed, and consequences may be applied in response to their actions.
