



# ONEHUNGA HIGH SCHOOL UNIFORM GUIDE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

As the school uniform shop is not located on the school campus, students host families will take them to the uniform store so they can purchase their school uniform.

The uniform supplier is: The Uniform Shoppe Penrose - 3/726 Great South Road, Penrose, Auckland. Open hours are Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday from 2:30PM to 5:30PM and Saturday from 9:30AM to 1:00PM.

## **IMPORTANT NOTE**

As the uniform shop is not open every day, you will need to check that your arrival into NZ allows you time to visit the uniform shop before you start school, as you are not permitted to attend classes if you are not wearing school uniform. Please note the below arrival days generally determine if you will have time to purchase your uniform in person at the store, or if you will need to purchase it online.

## **ARRIVAL DAY**

Monday - you can visit the store on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Saturday

Tuesday - you can visit the store on Wednesday, Thursday or Saturday

Wednesday - you can visit the store on Thursday or Saturday

Thursday - you must visit the store on Saturday

Friday - you must visit the store on Saturday

Saturday - you need to purchase your uniform online

Sunday - you need to purchase your uniform online

Monday - Orientation Day & Start School

If you need to order your school uniform online, please do so at least 7 days in advance of your school start date, and have it shipped to the school (Onehunga High School, 24 Pleasant Street, Onehunga, Auckland). Please make sure that you write your full name in the notes on your order. We will then give you your uniform on your orientation day. If an item is not the correct size, it can be exchanged on Tuesday afternoon by visiting the shop in person.

The below items are what we recommend purchasing for each year level at a minimum:

## YEAR 9, YEAR 10 & YEAR 11 STUDENTS

- Boys should purchase at least 1x Grey Junior Shirt, 1x Shorts or Trouser & 1x Jersey
- Girls should purchase at least 1x White Junior Blouse, 1x Junior Skirt or Girls Pant & 1x Jersey

## YEAR 12 & YEAR 13 STUDENTS

- Boys should purchase at least 1x White Senior Shirt, 1x Trouser & 1x Jersey
- Girls should purchase at least 1x White Senior Blouse, 1x Senior Skirt or Girls Pant & 1x Jersey
- Boys & Girls can consider purchasing 1x Red Tie if they would like to wear one

## PHYSICAL EDUCATION (PE) UNIFORM

- Year 9 & 10 students: PE is a mandatory subject for you
- Year 11, 12 & 13 students: PE subjects are optional for you (Physical Education or Physical Training & Sports)
- If you either must take PE or if you will choose to take PE as one of your subjects, and you will study at OHS for 10 weeks or less, you may wear plain black sports clothes if you do not wish to purchase the PE Uniform. If you will study at OHS for more than 10 weeks, you must purchase 1x PE Tee & 1x PE Short

## WEATHER DEPENDANT UNIFORM

- **Warmer Months (Jan, Feb, Mar, Nov, Dec)**
- We recommend purchasing at least 2x shirts
- Consider purchasing a bucket hat to help protect you from the sun
- **Colder Months (Apr, May, Jun, Jul, Aug, Sep, Oct)**
- We recommend purchasing 1x jacket
- Consider purchasing a scarf to help keep you warm

## UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

- Students hair must be clean and tidy, of natural colour and excesses of current fashions are not acceptable
- Faces are to be clean-shaven (no facial hair is permitted)
- Students may wear a small, plain gold or silver stud or small plain sleeper earring in the lobe of each ear
- Nose piercings, or any other facial piercings are not permitted
- Tattoos, cultural or otherwise, must not be visible, unless permission is provided by the school
- Students may wear a watch of any design (during exams or tests smart watches will need to be removed)
- Any non-regulation uniform items, including jewellery will be confiscated by a staff member

Students must ensure they also purchase the correct school shoes before starting school. School shoes do not have to be purchased from the school uniform shop. They can be purchased from any available store that sells them (Number One Shoes + Hannahs in NZ should have a range of available options and prices).

The following shoes are examples of acceptable and non-acceptable footwear. Acceptable shoes are defined as: Plain low cut black formal leather shoes (that do not cover the ankle) or black sandals. No sports shoes, sneakers or casual shoes, or coloured logos on shoes or sandals.

## SOCKS

- Boys should wear plain black socks that sit slightly above the ankle when wearing shorts or trousers
- Girls should wear plain white ankle socks when wearing a skirt or trousers
